## CHIANG MAI – CHIANG RAI

### – Breakfast at the hotel

Morning drive overland to Chiang Rai, sightseeing en route (Approximately 3 hour drive on good, paved road, mostly 4 lanes)

*December 26*

## OPTIONAL STOPS

**1. Wat Rongkhun Chiang Rai:** This is a modern museum designed by artist Chalermchai Kositpipat, entirely in white with mirrored glass. It has a fine blend of Buddhist art with contemporary themes.

**2. Chiang Saen:** An ancient city which was probably part of the Yonok Kingdom, which buildings and moat were actually built around 1328. (Sights to see: National Museum, Wat Chedi Luang Temple, Wat Pa Sak Temple set in forest of teak trees, Wat Phratha Chomkitti Temple with ancient gilded chedi and a fantastic view of the city and river)

**3. Opium Museum:** A Thai opium museum.

**4. Cabbage & Condom:** A community based rural development center ([www.pda.or.th/wpp/index\\_e.htm](http://www.pda.or.th/wpp/index_e.htm))

Lunch at a local restaurant

Upon arrival, transfer to check-in at the Anantara Resort

Dinner on own
