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KIPLING & CLARK *intinerary* | CAMBODIA EXTENSION

DAY 1: ARRIVE—SIEM REAP

Upon arrival at the airport in Siem Reap, meet and transfer to the Raffles Hotel d-Angkor for checkin.

Start with an afternoon tour of the Angkor complex to visit the magnificent and most impressive Angkor Wat. End the tour by climbing the steps of Phnom Bakheng—a small hillock, for an unprecedented view of the Angkor and the surrounding forests at sunset. You may want to take an optional elephant ride to the summit—great fun! Return to the Raffles for their unique dinner buffet.

DAY 2: SIEM REAP

Morning exploration of the South Gate of Angkor Tohm, Bayon, Baphoun, Terrace of the Leper King and Terrace of Elephants. Return to the hotel for lunch on your own. Afternoon excursion to Banteay Srei, 26 km by road from the town of Siem Reap. This temple is the most perfect example of stone carving amongst the Khmer temples made from pink sandstone. Also visit the mysterious and often photographed Ta-Prohm temple, where huge tree trunks grow through the ancient stones.

DAY 3: SIEM REAP

Morning sightseeing includes further exploration of the wondrous ancient ruins of Angkor sites of Prah Khan, Neak Pean and Prasat Kravan. Return to the hotel for lunch at leisure. Enjoy an afternoon boat ride on Tonle Sal Lake, a quiet oasis where it is possible to catch a glimpse of rural Cambodian life.

DAY 4: SIEM REAP— PHNOM PENH

Transfer from the hotel to Siem Reap airport for a morning flight to Phnom Penh. Upon arrival in Phnom Penh, meet at the airport and transfer to the Raffles Hotel Le Royal. In the afternoon we visit the notorious and sobering Tuol Sleng Museum, the former Khmer Rouge prison camp, and on to the infamous “Killing Fields” of Choueng Elk, where over 8,900 victims were executed and exhumed. Of all the people taken to Tuol Sleng, only seven survived. Lunch is at Khmer Surin.

This evening you are transferred by cyclos to the Foreign Correspondent’s Club of Cambodia for cocktails and dinner. After dinner, you will return to your hotel by motorchaoch.

(note: Tuol Sleng Museum is closed on Mondays.)

Raffles Hotel Le Royal. (B, L, D)

DAY 5: DEPART— PHNOM PENH

Breakfast at hotel.

This morning after breakfast, you will visit the Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda, and its surrounding compound. The National Museum of Khmer Art and Archeology is considered one of the finest museums of classical Cambodian Art in the world.

(Note: The National Museum is closed on Mondays.)

Transfer to Phnom Penh airport for departure flight. (B)
